A Note from our Grand President...

As Grand Council President I would like to have our Council come out on top of the Pro-Patria Raffle Ticket Sales. As of February 22, our Council had a 21.31% share of members purchasing tickets. We will not hit the 100% success rate of Dos Palos Council #99 where 18 out of 18 members bought tickets.

In terms of our Council #32 numbers - We have 183 members and only 39 members have purchased tickets. That means 144 members have not bought tickets or about 80% of our membership roster.
