YMI Grand Council Session News:

Convention News- The 140th YMI Grand Council Sessions were held at Bally's Hotel in beautiful South Lake Tahoe from June 16th-19th. YMI #613 was well represented by 8 delegates (i.e., Br. Mike Dimech, Br. Mike Amato, Br. Mario Balistreri, Br. John Cleary, Br. Bob Fiorito, Br. Stephen Goulding, Br. Joe Soracco & Br. Jeff Morrow). The Grand Council Sessions went very smoothly this year, including all held delegate

events. Many thanks to the Grand Council Session Planning Committee Chair **Br. Tom Fourie #32** and Committee members (**Br. Bob Bartoli #32**, **Br. Mike Dimech & Br. Mike Amato).** The following are highlights of this year's Sessions.

- Grand Council Elections 2025-26:
 - Elections took place with all Grand Council offices getting filled. Heading the slate of officers are Br. Bill Walls #80 & Br. Richard Murphy #32, who were selected as the Grand President and Grand 1st Vice President respectively.
 - YMI #613 was well-represented on the YMI Grand Council next year by the following YMI #613 Brothers:
 - Grand 2nd Vice President: Br. Mario Balistreri
 - Grand Secretary: Br. Mike Dimech
 - Grand Inside Sentinel : Br. Bob Fiorito
 - Grand Directors: Br. Mike Amato & Br. John Cleary
 - Br. Mike Amato was named the Chairman of the Board of YMI Grand Directors again.
- By Law Changes: All six By-Law Proposals presented by the State of the Institute Committee were easily approved. This year's By-Law Proposals were mainly administrative (e.g. reducing committee sizes; clarifying By-Law language, discrepancies, and processes; & officially adding a new advanced technology committee). The changes adopted should improve how YMI operates. We thank Br. Mike Dimech and Br. Mike Amato who served on this year's State of the Institute Committee chaired by Br. Steve Cresci #32.
- Insurance Assessment Fee Increase With the cost of liability insurance rising substantially lately, the YMI delegates authorized a \$4 per member annual increase. This increase should eliminate the noted shortfall between billed YMI insurance fees and funds collected for insurance through Council assessments. The fee increase will commence in July 2025.

- YMI Seminarian Education Foundation (SEF): The SEF awarded 39 scholarships totaling \$24,100. Thanks to the efforts of Br. Cosmo Amato, YMI #613 sponsored 7 of those 39 scholarships with applicants coming from either St. Patrick's Seminary or the Salesian Seminary. 2 of the winners are YMI #613 Brothers: Br. - YMI SEF Elections: Br. Cosmo Amato was elected to another 3-year term to serve on the SEF Board.
- YMI Fundraising Raffle: Over \$2600 was raised via three 50/50 raffles held during the Sessions. Half of the funds (about \$1300) were donated evenly to 2 charities:
